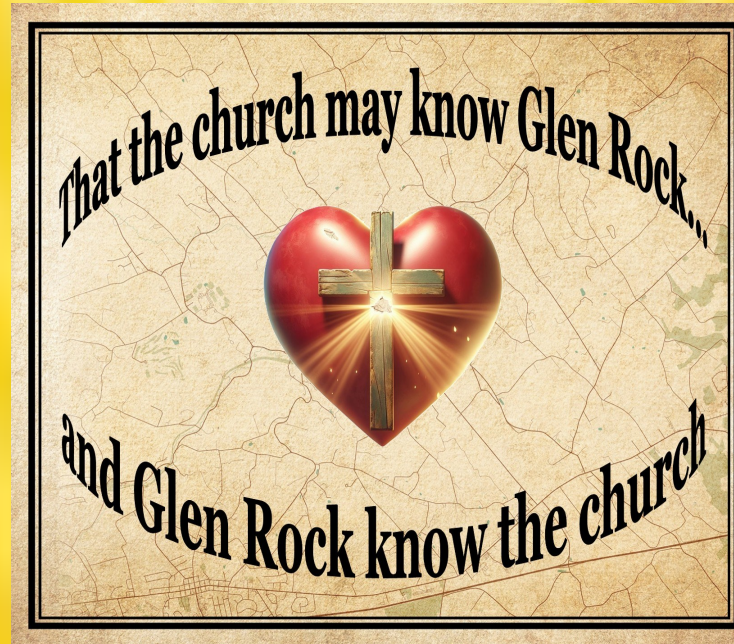


### ***Prayer Request***
