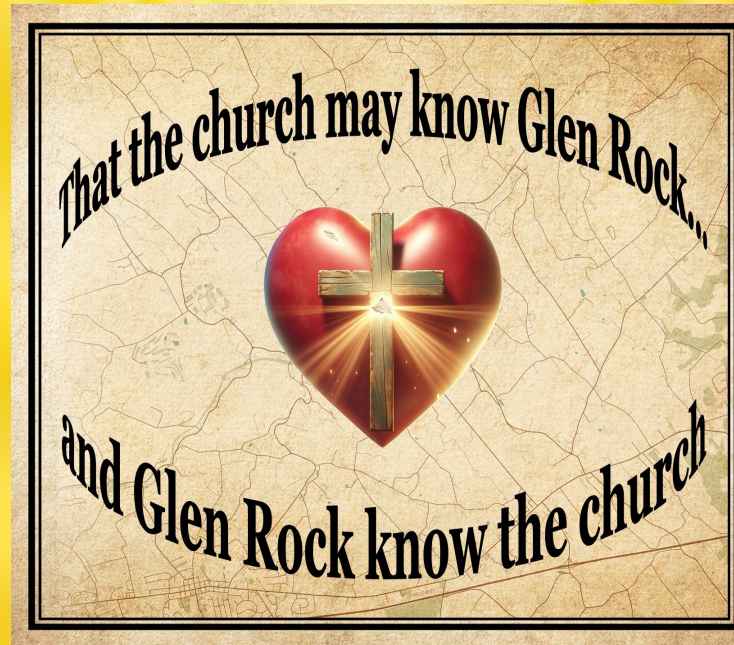


Prayer Request
