
Prayer Request

After we eat, Jeffrey will go over the prayer walk and depending on the amount people give groups a map of where to walk and pray. This is a prayer walk, not a door knocking.

What Is A Prayer Walk?

A prayer walk, simply put, is going somewhere with the intention of lifting up prayers for people and situations along the way. It is a kind of "moving intercession," and is a wonderful way of following Paul's instruction in 1 Thessalonians to "pray continually." As we walk, we look and see what life is like around us.

Next Sunday we will break into small groups after our lunch and collective prayer time, and walk in different areas around Glen Rock. We want you to pray for the souls of the people who live in the houses you are walking by. If we know someone in that neighborhood, we will ask you to pray for them outside their house. Pray for the physical and spiritual needs of the people who live on that street. Even though they are unknown to us, God knows their needs. Pray that the Holy Spirit will open doors for us as a church to interact with people who live on that street. If there is a business on the street where you walk, pray for the owner and workers in that business.

A list of Bible verses will be given and you are welcome to pray those scriptures back to God as you walk. You can pray aloud as small group or quietly in your own head. You decide. The key is to be intentional with your prayer and be open to the Holy Spirit while you walk and pray.

If people desire, we can meet back at the church building and share our prayer walk time and how God opened our hearts and how the Spirit lead us.
