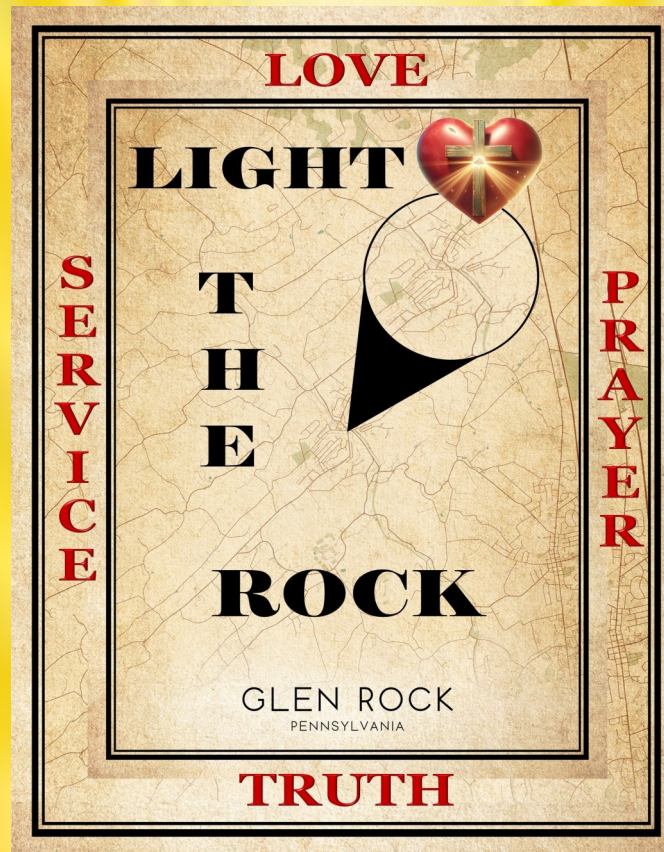


Prayer Request
