Mt. 10:5-7, Go! The lesson for us: Go to the lost sheep and as you go, preach. Use simple conversations, from Casual to Meaningful to Spiritual to using tools like DBS (Discovery Bible Study) bookmarks.

Mt. 10:16, Sheep among Wolves is how we go out to: **Love, Learn and Lead**. Growing in these areas as we share Christ.

Love, Jn 13:35, All will know we are His disciples by our “love for one another”. As disciples among wolves we must love each other deeply. The wolves, bite and devour. People act that way, will see the difference love makes. Jesus loved those who would not listen, **Mt. 23:37**.

Learn, Rom. 12:1-2, “do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind”. Ultimately, the warfare is spiritual, **Eph. 6:12**, leaving man's worldview to follow God.

Lead, Mt. 28:19-20, disciples of Jesus attempt to lead people to Jesus, teaching to observe His commands.

Mt.10:20, As we go we have the Spirit of God with us, **Rom. 8:10-11**.

Mt. 10:38-39, Find your life in Him, Finding our life in Jesus, means we no longer seek what we want in life, but what He wants. Seek Him first, **Mt. 6:33**.
